Ring density is highly variable, and antique heartwood content ranges greatly.

Standard Dimensions

2.5" - 11.5" wide planks (wider w/ special order) 2' to 12' lengths 3/4" thick, tongue-and-groove

Grain

Straight, with irregularities, figure, and variable heartwood content. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Heartwood ranges from delicate yellows through oranges and into red and reddish-brown. Sapwood is a pleasant yellowish-white.

Character

Knots, nail holes, mineral staining, plugged bolt holes, minor checking

Hardness & Stability

A moderately hard and stable wood. $870lb_f$ on the Janka hardness scale. ~ 2.56 pounds per square foot.
