

This floor is re-milled out of Heart Pine factory flooring salvaged from an 1800s Massachusetts paper mill. New tongue-and-groove milling and a fresh face. Character: Rustic! There is a top nail pattern every 18" and a smattering of smaller nail holes at random across the surface. Color ranges from vibrant yellow to dark umber, although it is generally reddish amber.

If you're looking for reclaimed flooring, ceiling paneling, or wall paneling that looks as though it's seen 100 years of action, this is an option to consider.

Standard Dimensions

2.75" & 3.75" wide planks
2' to 12' lengths
3/4" thick, tongue-and-groove



Grain

Straight, with minor irregularities and figure. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Color ranges from vibrant yellow to dark umber, although it is generally reddish amber.

Character

Cart tracks, nailholes, minor checking, dents, worn surface, and knots.

Hardness & Stability

A moderately hard and stable wood. 870lb_f on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.56 pounds per square foot.
