

# Reclaimed Skip-Planed Oak



Our reclaimed skip-planed oak flooring is a mixture of red and white oak run through a planer that removes only certain areas of the reclaimed patina, leaving behind original saw marks and natural distress. Skip-planed oak floors are hard, durable, and stable - perfect for high-traffic environments.

With a natural habitat ranging from Quebec to Florida, oaks have played a major role in the development of American infrastructure. Species have been used in shipbuilding, mill assembly, barn construction, and residential building.

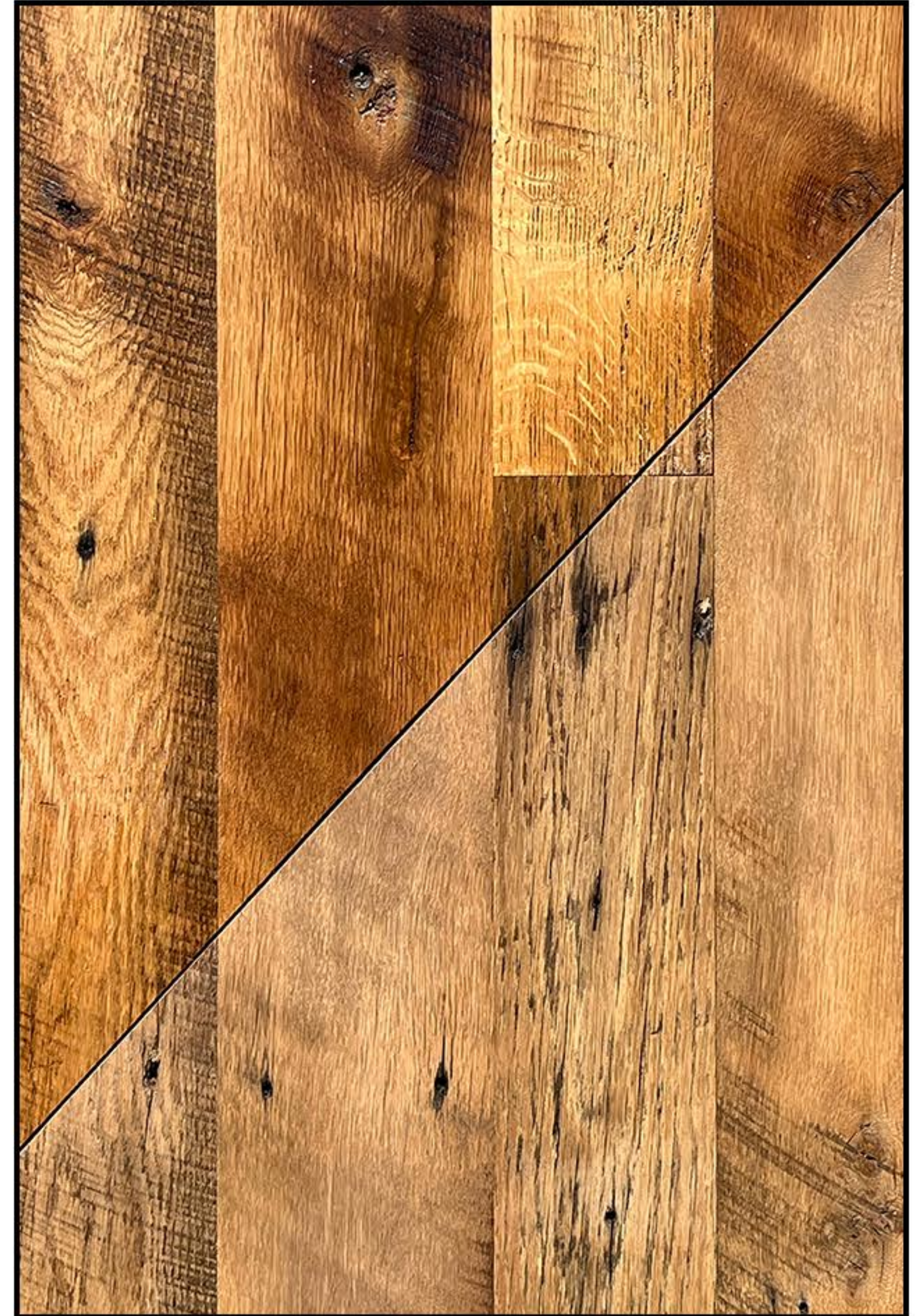
## Standard Dimensions

2.5" - 8.5" wide planks (*wider w/ special order*)

2' to 12' lengths

3/4" thick

Tongue-and-groove and end-matched.



## Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

## Color

Ranges from brown to black in areas of original surface. Planed areas from light to medium brown through whites, with reddish or olive cast.

## Character

Original surface features circular or bandsawn texture, planed surface features knots, checking, some wormwood, nail holes, and mineral stains. Wider boards will be expertly mended with butterfly/Dutchman patches when needed.

## Hardness & Stability

Hard and stable woods. ~1,285lb<sub>f</sub> on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.84 pounds per square foot.



## Certifications

Qualifies for LEED MRc3, Materials Reuse credit. May qualify for LEED MRc5, Regional Materials credit.
