

Possessing more rustic character, our reclaimed #2 Vertical Grain (quartersawn) Heart Pine flooring contains knots up to 1.5" in diameter, occasional nail holes, and minimal light checking. Mineral stains may present themselves as exquisite, unpredictable alterations. Growth ring concentration of eight to the inch and greater.

Our #2 Vertical Grain (quartersawn) Heart Pine is graded with 90% or better heartwood content. There will be some rift grain (up to 10%) present.

Standard Dimensions

2-1/2" - 5.5" wide planks
2' to 12' lengths
3/4" thick

Grain

Straight, with minor irregularities and figure. 90% + heartwood content.

Color

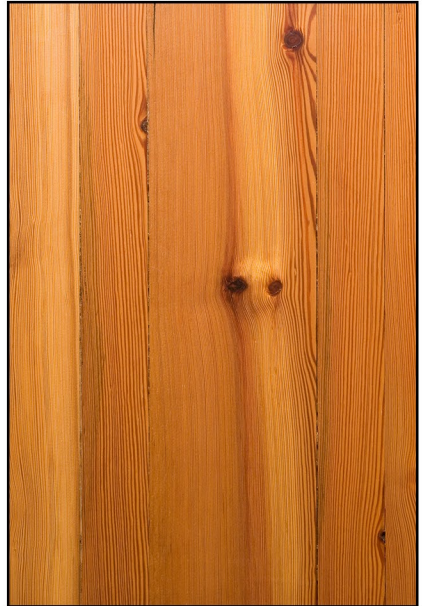
Heartwood ranges from delicate yellows through oranges and into red and reddish-brown. Sapwood, if present, is a pleasant yellowish-white.

Character

Knots up to 1.5" in diameter and small nail holes. Minor, if any, checking and mineral staining.

Hardness & Stability

A moderately hard and stable wood. 1225lb_f^{anecdotal} on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.56 pounds per square foot.
