Reclaimed Eastern White Pine is a softer wood with coloration ranging from a light blonde to deep amber. Our Bright-Planed White Pine flooring is a resurfaced product milled from antique boards and/or beams. It includes light checking, occasional nail holes and knots, and presents diverse visual elements of character and use.

Virgin white pine has been aggressively harvested since the colonial era. Today, white pine is farmed and sawn for lumber as quickly as possible, making it entirely different than product milled from our reclaimed old-growth timber.

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Ranges from white/blonde and fine golden color to brown with occassional reddish hue.

Character

Knots, nail holes, checking, and mineral stains are incorporated into this grade.

Hardness & Stability

A soft and stable wood. 380lb $_{\rm f}$ on the Janka hardness scale. ~1.56 pounds per square foot.
