

Reclaimed Red Oak



Our reclaimed Red Oak flooring ranges in coloration, size, and character. A traditional oak flooring, it features knots, some nail holes, and occasional surface checking. This character, along with inherent strength and hardness, has made Red Oak a wood of choice for homeowners, woodworkers, and green builders time and time again.

Longleaf mills reclaimed Red Oak tongue-and-groove flooring in 3/4" thickness. We expertly mend wider boards with butterfly/Dutchman patches.



Standard Dimensions

2.5" - 12" wide planks (*wider w/ special order*)

2' to 12' lengths

3/4" thick

Tongue-and-groove & end-matched.

Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Ranges from medium or light brown to whitish, often with a reddish cast. Ray flecking less prominent than White Oak.

Character

Knots, checking, some wormwood, nail holes, and accompanying mineral stains are present and desirable. Wider boards will be expertly mended with butterfly/Dutchman patches.

Hardness & Stability

A hard and stable wood. 1,220lb_f on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.75 pounds per square foot.
