

Reclaimed from a variety of industrial sources, our 'Run-of-the-Mill' Heart Pine Flooring is a healthy mixture of 2-1/2" #2 flatsawn, #2 vertical grain (quartersawn), and #3 rustic grades. Composed of vertical grain and off-center flatsawn boards, this floor delivers the color and character of reclaimed Heart Pine at a modest price point. Narrow widths serve for added stability.

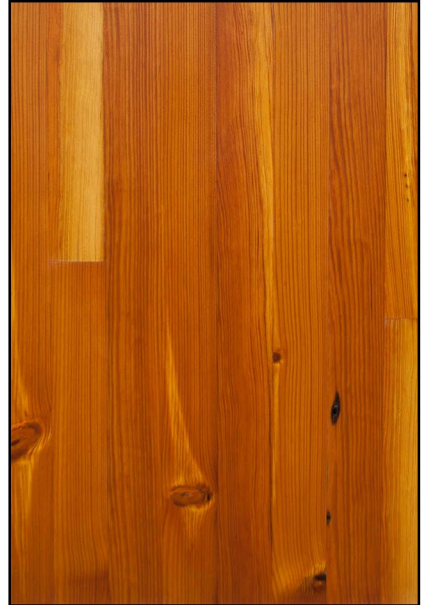
Ring density is at Heart Pine levels, and antique heartwood content ranges.

Standard Dimensions

2.5" wide planks

2' to 12' lengths

3/4" thick, tongue-and-groove



Grain

Straight, with irregularities, figure, and variable heartwood content. Mixed flat and vertical grain (quartersawn). Some wider grain for variable ring density.

Color

Heartwood ranges from yellow to orange, with sapwood ranging from pale whitish to yellows. Mineral staining may occur, presenting shades and tones of gray.

Character

Knots, nail holes, mineral staining, pith, and checking.

Hardness & Stability

A moderately hard and stable wood. 1225lb_f on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.56 pounds per square foot.

Qualifies for LEED MRc3, Materials Reuse credit. May qualify for LEED MRc5, Regional Materials credit.
