2.5" - 12" wide planks (wider w/ special order)
2' to 12' lengths
3/4" thick
Tongue-and-groove & end-matched.



Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Ranges from light to medium brown, sometimes with olive or greenish cast. Sapwood, if present, can be whiter. Ray fleck patterning present in varying quantities.

Character

Knots, checking, some wormwood, nail holes, and accompanying mineral stains are present and desirable. Wider boards will be expertly mended with butterfly/Dutchman patches.

Hardness & Stability

A hard and stable wood. 1,350lb, on the Janka hardness scale. ~2.93 pounds per square foot.
